REGULATION of the CHALLENGE



General Regulation

Article nº 1 – Goal

- a) The main goal of this challenge is to defy the creativity of students in the several areas of civil engineering and by this cultivate the awareness of those by searching for ingenious solutions. Also developing competences that promote team work, leadership and coordination;
- b) The goal is to complete all three challenges with the best rating possible respecting the rules of the following general regulation and each challenge regulation.

Article nº 2 – Registration

- a) The registration is open to all students of the Integrated Master's in Civil Engineering of the Faculty of Engineering of University of Porto;
- b) The teams are formed by 3 students each, limited to 5 teams;
- c) The registration must be done between 5th and 14th of May 13 of 2019 by feeling in the form (<https://forms.gle/JhfpeKcAS1DWzaL37>)

Article nº 3 – Challenge day

- a) The challenge will be held on 15th of May 2019 at FEUP in designated spaces for each challenge. The realization of the activities is restricted to the times and places established by IACES-LC Porto;
- b) Each activity will focus on one field of civil engineering: Construction, Structures and Hydraulics;
- c) The opening of ICEC local stage will be at room Joaquim Sarmiento. The Hydraulics and Structures challenges will take place in the morning, followed by a pause for lunch and afterward the Construction challenge. The activity will end with the revelation of the results and awards delivery again at room Joaquim Sarmiento;
- d) All activities will be in English to uniform the competition with the others ICEC local phases;
- e) All participating students will have justified absences from classes on the 15th of May 2019.

Article nº 4 – Challenge classification

- a) Each challenge will have its different evaluation system supervised or aided by professors and the rules of the procedure are contemplated in the regulation of the respective challenge.
- b) The higher sum of the scores in each challenge will reveal the winner of the competition
- c) The three elements of the winning team will be awarded 150€ in card and will participate in the ICEC final phase with the winning teams, from the different local stages, to be held in Porto between 7th and 14th July 2019. In this final phase it will be awarded 600€ to the winning team.

Article nº 5 – Complaints

- a) IACES-LC Porto may revoke any team participation if the challenge requirements are disrespected or violated.
- b) Any aspect not foreseen in this regulation will be decided by IACES-LC Porto.
